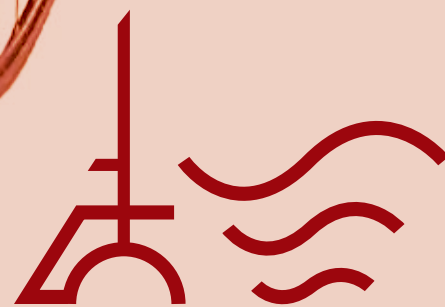

Last August, the organizers of the 19th edition of Paris-Brest-Paris Randonneur® installed their base camp in the vast green oasis of Rambouillet Castle Park. The site has a lot of character, even in the rain.

No need to count the Bergerie Nationale sheep, they were far fewer than the thousands of riders and guests we welcomed.

Under a clear sky, but with headwind, the riders, who had dreamed for years of this moment, were given the opportunity to head for Brest, and tackle a 1219 km long expedition, including 11,800 meters of climbing amount. A participation record was broken, but given the very (too) high rate of dropouts and out-of-time, the number of homologations is lower than in 2015.

The magic once again happened, with volunteers cheering, comforting, admiring the riders, and with local residents cheering, refueling and discussing, day and night, as best they can, with participants from around the world.

Congratulations to the riders who took up the challenge, to the control towns, to all volunteers, who did an outstanding, very appreciated job, and to all those who worked for the success of this 19th edition.

See you in 2023, a year before the Olympic Games in Paris, for the 20th edition, which, no doubt, will be even more beautiful.

Yvelines. Paris-Brest-Paris. Rambouillet becomes an international city.

In Rambouillet (Yvelines), from Friday, August 16, the first effects of Paris-Brest-Paris are felt in town, where all languages are spoken.

In front of the Bergerie, home of the merinos, Chinese riders admire a funny German bicycle.

English, Japanese, Spanish, German, Chinese. All languages are spoken in **Rambouillet**. This is the first effect of **Paris-Brest-Paris**.

At Place Felix-Faure and Place de la Libération, the people of Rambouillet are happy to rub shoulders with all nationalities. «See, I am surrounded by Englishmen and Germans. It's Europe, it's European reconciliation!» a resident says cheerfully, happy also to see the first benefits for local traders.

At Place Felix-Faure, riders like to sit, eat, or have a drink. A little further, Japanese riders visit the Castle of Rambouillet.



Then we meet Chinese, Indians, Thais.

Jean-Pierre Chardon, Assistant Project Manager, declared: «Many came from the other side of the planet. Of course, they came over to ride PBP, but also to visit France, and discover our specialties. The economic impact of Paris-Brest-Paris is very important!».

Apart from the 1572 registered French riders, there were also 702 from Germany, 563 from the UK, 461 from the USA, 392 from Japan, and 325 from India. Thierry Rivet, President of Audax Club Parisien, said: «There were only 2 Indians in 2011. All these nationalities are fond of long-distance riding. We have local correspondents who promote long-distance riding. The Japanese are particularly fond of those events.



And Paris-Brest-Paris is mythical. It was first run in the racing version in 1891, and we offer it in the rando version since 1931». At the Bergerie, excitement grows. Cyclists and tourists enjoy the Rambolitan countryside, and discover a heritage site erected by the kings of France.

Tradition, «a little more mythical», and «bucolic», each of the start and finish places that welcomed you during the last 3 PBPs had advantages and disadvantages for you and us. Each time, we had to adapt to local requirements, to do with the existing, and to innovate in order to welcome you as best as possible. In 2019, you participated in even greater numbers than usual: 66 countries - 6674 registered riders - 6418 at the start of this international event.

The weather was not very nice before the start, and the nights during the ride were particularly cold, which partially explains the high percentage of dropouts.

On our side, there have been imperfections, but aren't there always some?

In Rambouillet, we sometimes ran out of volunteers, while the presents did all they could. There are differences between forecasts and out-turns...

The city of Rambouillet woke up under a stream of cyclists, and some people came spontaneously to offer their help, which was not easy to manage, as we got stuck into the work!

We often had to deal with the most urgent, and we must tell that some participants made it more difficult for us, as well as for their fellow riders, by picking up directional arrows on the route. We had to hurry, replace missing arrows, and recover lost, tired riders!

We also regret that some participants did not respect our traffic and parking instructions. Yet the bikers of ANEC helped the riders as much as they could.

We also deplore thefts - theft of the toilet lighting, for example, that we had to replace in the night by candles! And I will not list all things that were carried away (as a souvenir?), even camp beds!

In short, we find here all facets of our society. Fortunately, there were also good times, such as when we talked together and socialized with the participants. We will try to retain only those good aspects.

The rider tracking had a very great success, and media interest in PBP is growing edition after edition.

The assistance and medical services all along the route were up to the event, even if there are still improvements to be made. The volunteers at the control places, and the French Train Company, helped repatriation, and many riders asked for it.

We have a large amount of found objects, which their owners will hopefully get back!

When taking stock of the event, as head organizer, I would like to congratulate all the people and institutions who have worked together for the best success of PBP 2019. How much work was done before, during, and after the event (administrative procedures, logistics, supplies, registrations, processing of files, rider tracking, and so on), by a big chain of volunteers - belonging or not to the Audax Club Parisien, who had a unique idea in mind, make live this PBP!

So, I thank very strongly:

The people from the Bergerie Nationale de Rambouillet (National Sheepfold) for all the help they have given us at all times, making themselves always available, always in a good mood; the City of Rambouillet, its sports department and its administrative service; the President of the Rambouillet Cycling Club, who was very generous with his time; the Police and Gendarmerie of Rambouillet, with whom we established a relationship of trust; the Prefecture of Yvelines; the Tourist Office; all people in charge of our welcome sites, their municipalities and services; Chrono Course; Orange; the Civil Protection; the Firefighters; the EMS and Ambulance; the Insurer; the Caterers; the ANEC; and the more than 2000 volunteers, who contributed to the realization of this memorable event.

I also have a thought for all the victims of more or less serious accidents (no deaths this year), and I wish them the best possible recovery to be able to return in 2023!

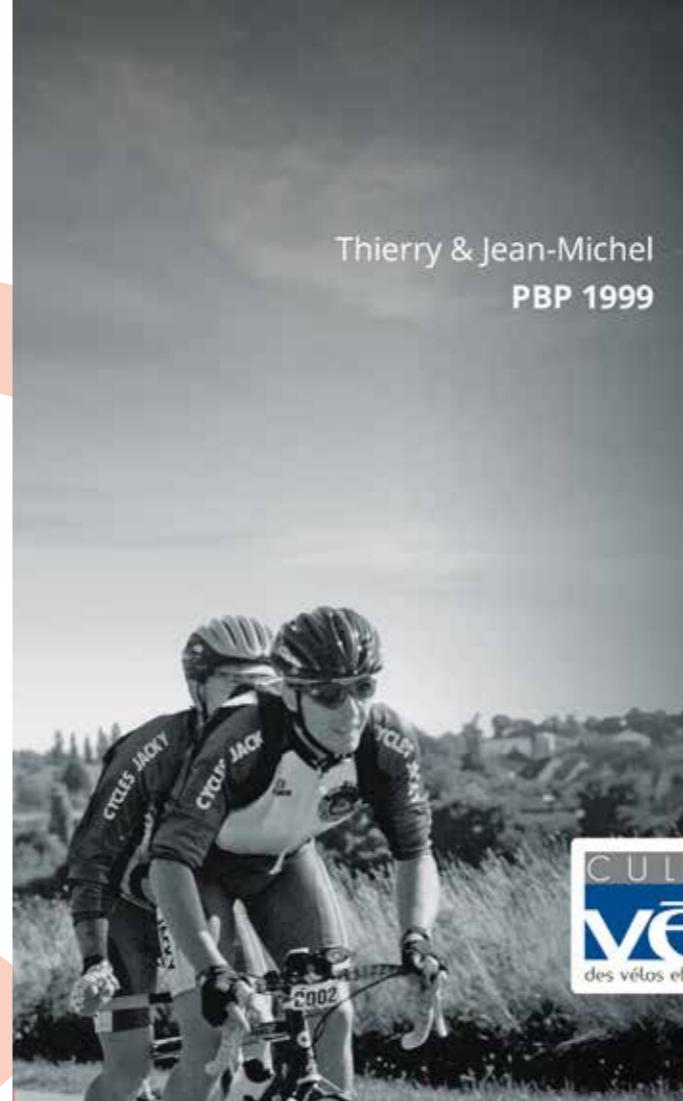

Dreux

The reception of the 19th Paris-Brest-Paris Randonneur was very challenging for the Vélo Sport Drouais. Start and finish place of the great international rider meeting was located in Rambouillet. Therefore, the distance between Dreux (the last checkpoint), and the finish, was shorter than in previous editions.

Of course, from the sporting point of view, lots of «It's almost over, there are only 45 km to go, and you're done» were heard from the mouth of our 120 volunteers, who took turns over 3 days. We think that, for the participants, this last stage has already a taste of successful challenge.

However, from the organizational point of view, we are wondering what the participants will do. Will they stop to rest a few time, sleep, eat, or just have their card validated, gather their strength, and keep riding, to better enjoy the finish in Rambouillet? Anyway, we



want to ensure that they are receiving all what they need, so we collect a maximum of beds, tables and chairs, as well as barriers, to secure our premises and set up the bike park... Too much is better than too little, at the risk of making the municipal services work for nothing. The caterer also thinks big: «They will still be hungry!»...

After many meetings - internally, with the PBP organizers, with the services of the City of Dreux, and with the township community, we are ready. We wish to warmly thank all our partners.

Friday, August 16. Time for briefing with the volunteers from the Vélo Sport Drouais, and from many other cycling clubs of the department, without forgetting those who will be present without being connected with bicycle tourism, e.g. the interpreters. In Dreux, we work around the clock. The 200 time slots are allocated. Everyone is explained his or her role. All have a great motivation, some of them because they have already volunteered, and have appreciated the job, others because it is a first-time experience, about which they have heard so much.

Sunday, we have fun! Riders will check in Dreux only on the return, so we have time to go and see them taking off. We are lucky, we spotted an ideal viewpoint to see them arrive



and pass in front of us. After only forty kilometers from the start in Rambouillet, shortly after Nogent-le-Roi, they take a large bridge over the road RN 154, a little south of Dreux. The info circulated, and cyclists came from all over the department.

The first riders form fairly dense groups. A little later, groups become less important. Then come the special bikes, which arouse many comments on the roadside. The riders seem to appreciate our small group of spectators, and stretch their hands as they pass by, so that we give them high-fives. Some stop to fill their bottles. Despite the very low mileage traveled, we see, in the middle of concentrated or relaxed faces, a handful of participants who look already tired! ... Later, the night begins to fall. A long line of lights appears in the landscape. The magic operates. We keep in mind that we are going to live 4 intense days in Dreux...

Monday is dedicated to the setup of the site:

- The area around the stadium, for the rider entry and exit, the car parks for support vehicles and officials, the bike park, and the bike repair service, hold by the volunteers of our club.

- The Palais des Sports, with control place and catering in the gymnasium, and dormitory in the official hall. The floors of the two rooms must be covered, to protect the parquet.

Everyone is busy with warning tape, adhesive tape, drill, protective pose, installation of beds ... With ingenuity, good mood and muscle, everything goes well.

Tuesday is traditionally calm. The arrival of the first three riders at the Palais des Sports marks the beginning of our task. As soon as they have their cards stamped, they greet us, and disappear very



quickly. Soon after them, to our surprise, the first recumbent arrives. The arrivals will then follow one another, going crescendo. We still have time to improve our facilities.

Then it goes on, almost naturally. The volunteers are faithful to their commitments. Every six hours, the teams are totally or partially renewed, and those leaving do not fail to brief the newcomers.

Attendance peaks on Thursday morning, and we quickly find the answer to our initial questioning. So close to the finish, many riders stop, sleep, eat ... Phew, we are not only stamp machines!

Then, the attendance weakens. It's official control closing time. Before storing everything, for several hours, we welcome the latecomers.



Above all, we will remember the atmosphere of mutual respect between participants and hosts. We are in awe of their courage, and warmly congratulate them. On the other side, although their faces bear the traces of the long ride, despite stiff legs and painful necks, there is always a smile for us, a thank you to us. This strengthens our respect, and our desire to congratulate all those who, in realizing their dream, have allowed us to share with them this great moment of sport, Paris-Brest-Paris.

Mortagne-au-Perche

As with every edition, the whole team of Randonneurs du Perche was happy and very motivated to welcome the PBP riders. About 150 people volunteered, and the site of Carré du Perche put on its best suit to welcome these 6400 cyclists.

After the passage of the first riders, who just gave us a shout-out (Mortagne-au-Perche was not a control place on the way to Brest), the site was quickly filled, and everyone at work. Catering, refreshment bar, and outdoor grill were very busy.

Congratulations to our caterer, who was always very responsive, so that everyone was served as quickly as possible.

Surprisingly, many riders wished to sleep during the first night, often on the tables, or on the floor, not wanting to go to the dormitories; we also had to manage about twenty dropouts.

The bike mechanic also was very busy during the first night, with breakdowns of all kinds that were not due to falls, to the point that we suspected some participants of having started with poorly prepared bikes, or in poor condition.



Until the passage of the 84 hour riders on Monday morning, everyone worked in joy and good humor, happy to be able to participate in the PBP other than on the bike.

For the extra flow of participants, we organized ourselves to avoid long queues, which worked well.

The return was much more fluid, except for the last night, when the management of dropouts and repatriation was very important. The work of the volunteers on this last night got also more complicated with all the cyclists sleeping everywhere.

This edition was a bit odd, with repatriation of riders who dropped out, and various problems, all the more that the language barrier was present, despite all efforts made by the interpreters.

Villaines-la-Juhel

Once again, the reception of the Paris-Brest-Paris Randonneur in Villaines-la-Juhel was up to the event. It's a ritual since 1979, the city welcomes thousands of cyclists from around the world.

From 9:30 pm on Sunday, August 18, the volunteers are at their respective positions. The pressure is rising slowly. Do not forget anything before the control opening, from the last glance at the site, to the last security instructions, in short: we are ready!

These swarms of cyclists, some of whom are tackling their first long-distance challenge, converge on Villaines-la-Juhel, their first control point. They occupy the roads. But for many tired riders, the need for sleep imperiously manifests itself, and if the road belongs to them, apparently the roadside also does. From Fresnay-sur-Sarthe to Villaines-la-Juhel, riders sleep next to their bike. They do not turn off their lighting, and sleep, in the best case on a bench, or on a pile of gravel, or even on the ground, a few dozen centimeters away from the road. Meanwhile, others are dashing for their first checkpoint, eating up the

kilometers.

It is now one o'clock in the morning, rush time. Hundreds of riders quickly take a breakfast, some will eat, warm up, have a soup at the self-service restaurant, others are already enjoying the massage at the medical station, and the interpreters are working around the clock, we need them everywhere. The control post records the first abandons, and the waves of riders follow one another without a break. A few falls are reported, and our support vehicles make their first trips on accidents. From the inside, all this is an irreplaceable experience. It is necessary for our volunteers to manage these huge «rush times» whilst smiling, and, for the duration of the event, solve any unforeseeable and inevitable problem.

Another great moment on Tuesday, August 20, 12 am: 31 young people (boys and girls) arrive, welcomed by a round of applause. They are riding their own Paris-Brest-Paris, organized by the French Federation of bicycle touring.

From August 20th early morning, to August 21st in the late afternoon, all riders are on their way back to Rambouillet. They are queuing in greater numbers at the self-service restaurant located in the premises of the school group Saint Nicolas. In the evening, all dormitories

are full with exhausted participants. For some of them, it will be difficult to finish the ride in less than 90 hours.



On Wednesday, Villaines-la-Juhel shows its best face, in honor of PBP. After more than 1000 kilometers ridden, riders are welcomed with music, fanfare, bagpipes, accordion, and Spanish songs, not to mention multiple animations. Our three animators interview the participants, as if they were pro riders finishing a Tour de France stage! All people in town are an exceptional and expert audience. They look at the riders with eyes full of admiration, and sometimes envy, they cheer and applaud them, as they have still 200 kilometers to go. All cycling clubs of Mayenne are present to encourage their friends, who are riding the 1200 km *randonnée*.

Bravo et merci ! Congratulations to all riders for your performance. You gave us a lot of joy, it was a pleasure to welcome you. We exchanged a lot during these four days. Thank you all, and thank you to ANEC for their help and interventions.

We thank all our partners who, once again, have contributed



to welcome the PBP riders: the City of Villaines-la-Juhel and its technical services, who provided indispensable support; the CCMA and the Departmental Council of Mayenne; artisans and local businesses; the ACT with the support of the festival committee for the animations; the Mayenne Cycling Committee and the clubs of Loupfougères and Retraite Sportive of Villaines-la-Juhel; the Tourist Office of Mont des Avaloirs; all the local medical staff and the Civil Protection of the Mayenne (484 medical care); the Rescue Center of Villaines-la-Juhel; our two bicycle dealers; the school group Saint Nicolas, who ensures since 1979 restoration, beds and showers, and above all, a huge thank you to the 400 volunteers, who mobilized day and night to welcome the participants, and be up to the PBP excitement and growth. Thank you to the Audax Club Parisien for trusting us, once again.

The 20th edition, in 2023, is already in our thoughts, with leitmotiv Welcome to Villaines-la-Juhel.

Tinténiac

Like every 4 years in August, Tinténiac welcomed the PBP riders.

The whole town was decorated. An artwork was placed in an important roundabout at the town entry, old bicycles were painted and enlivened by flowers of all colors, made with plastic bottles. These bicycles were judiciously laid out along the riders route: on the bridge crossing the canal of Ille et Rance, on the facades of the houses, and at many other places. All of this decor added to the party atmosphere in our city.

This control is held by the Amicale Cyclotouriste d'Ille et Rance (ACIR), whilst the whole «challenge» is organized by the Audax Club Parisien (ACP). For several editions, the heart our control is located in the premises of the school «BEL AIR». Local volunteers were 180 for this session. A dozen commissions have been created. For example, each volunteer works during 4 hours, then rests 8 hours. Every 4 years, in the summer, the volunteers know that it's going to be a big celebration, and they firmly intend to be part of it!

Four riders from the ACIR were riding. Two had already ridden PBP in 2015. This time, Olivier MARION finished in 79 hours (10 minutes faster than in 2015); Gérard Le GALL, Stéphane ORINEL and Yvon GUEDE dropped

out. In total, 28% of the participants dropped out.

At checkpoint Tinténiac, several services were provided: rider control (mandatory), refreshments, sandwiches, not to mention the famous sausage pancakes, and the self-restaurant... for those who were less in a hurry. Thanks to the President of the pork-butchers of Brittany, for having assured the meals in the school premises. Riders could also rest in the dormitories (4-bed rooms), and have their bikes repaired by our local bicycle dealer. The Civil Protection and a physiotherapist also were at the service of the riders.

Numerous shows were put on in the school courtyard: a local group of Breton music and dances, a puppeteer, a lottery organized by local traders (the first prize was an electric bike!), etc., and one of Bernard HINAULT's racing bikes was on display.

We can't wait for 2023, the year before the Olympic Games in France!

Quédillac

For the 2019 edition, we were 168 volunteers including 14 interpreters.

The first riders passed at 4:26 am on Monday (15 minutes later than in 2015).

We did not encounter any particular problem, except a Romanian motorhome that parked without our knowledge.

Our doctor intervened a dozen times: wounds due to falls, wasp stings, abdominal and muscular pains.

There were 121 interventions in mechanical assistance.

Sleeping: we had 150 mattresses available; about 300 beds were allocated



over three days; the dormitory was full on Wednesday morning with 170 people, so we added gym mats.

Our mobile phone recharge was also a great success, as well as the rider tracking.

Carhaix

This was the 11th edition for us in the centre of Brittany. Each time, we try to improve our control site, which the Region, the Proviseur, and the Intendant of the Lycée de Carhaix have made available to us.

The control of Carhaix could not be run without the help of our partners:

- . The Mayor of Carhaix, the Technical Service, the Sports Office, as well as their infrastructure.
- . The above mentioned Lycée de Carhaix.
- . Les Vieilles Charrues : various material + 400 linear meters of Heras barriers.
- . Local businesses provided various material.
- . The Civil Protection has done a remarkable job, with the help of some doctors. Provision of camp beds for 1 night.
- . The 450 volunteers, mobilized during more than 650 slots of 4 hours.

This year again, the young people of CLAJ have completed the flags of the represented countries.

Relationships with all our suppliers were excellent.

The ACAP (Association Carhai-

sienne Accueil Parisbrestparis) currently includes 26 Sports and Cultural Associations. It is an official association registered at the Prefecture, member of the Sports Office. One month after the festival Les Vieilles Charrues, which mobilizes more than 6500 volunteers, Carhaix has gathered 650 slots, so that the reception of riders and public was very satisfying.

Everyone felt concerned for 2.5 days by this sporting event, which requires several months of preparation for some, and 8 tough days.

The ACAP, through its President Jacques Le YONCOUR, thanks all the partners who made this success possible.

The hot food, fast food and bar were a success.

The bedding, with provision by the Civil Protection of camp beds for 1.5 nights, was insufficient, because of the many out-and-backs, as we are close to Brest.

The interpreters were very in demand, as well as internet, and the control by floor mat.

Security guarding, and security in and out of the site were at the top.

Despite the many out-and-backs, the controllers have done very well, they even extended the control opening by 2h45, to give a chance to the latecomers.



The Cycling Club of Carhaix had 9 participants in the 1219 km randonnée.

We deplore some accidents and incidents, as well as 682 dropouts between Loudéac and Brest, that is 11% of all in our sector.

On Friday evening, together with the municipality, we welcomed the young cyclists who rode their own PBP, and left Carhaix on Saturday morning.

The Cycling Club of Carhaix, through the ACAP, warmly thanks the ACP for their organization.

PBP WORLDWIDE

«Paris-Brest-Paris» has always been for me an «unreachable» event

but, having discovered the Brevets de Randonneurs Mondiaux 3 years ago, in my region in Grenoble, I gradually came to the idea that I, too, could line up at the start of the 2019 edition. To participate in this mythical event is an exceptional adventure.

The «recipe» of Paris-Brest-Paris is made of History, French landscapes, personal challenge, meetings with French and foreign cyclists, all sharing the same passion: cycling. In this alchemy, there is, above all, a very high level organization, and volunteers present day and night throughout the course, with incredible dedication and kindness. Not to mention the very numerous inhabitants, Bretons in particular, or cycling clubs from the crossed villages and countryside, which prepare light refueling with food and drinks. All that, I think, makes many participants come from all over the world.

My initial goal was to take the start of PBP, which of course involved qualifying, but I still doubted that I could reach the end of the 1219 kilometers. Now, with the hindsight of experience, I realize how lucky I

was to have been able to prepare myself properly, to have benefited from a favorable weather, and to have had no physical problem.

The fact of having left Rambouillet quite late (20h30) probably allowed me to tackle the first night in physical freshness. In my eyes, you ride Paris-Brest-Paris with your head, as well as with your legs. In order to keep riding, you must maintain your «fuel» level by feeding and drinking regularly, and by keeping the will to move forward. I constantly sought to ride with other riders, in order to save my energy, but also to challenge myself, and have fun. Riding with foreign cyclists dotted my ride with good moments! Even if I like cycling in all circumstances (sport, tourism, rides with family or friends, city ...), and therefore at very different pace, I noticed that I felt better when riding fast, and had more difficulties with slower groups.

And yet, it would have been more reasonable to ride at regulated and relaxed pace. It would have been much more difficult for me to ride alone at such sustained speed. Thanks to the atmosphere of «party», day and night, on the roads, in the crossed villages, and in the control places, thanks to emulation, and to the large number of very diverse participants, I never got bored, quite the contrary!

Canada

2019 was another challenging year for many Canadians who travelled to France to ride PBP, to experience a few intense days (and nights) cycling with thousands of fellow enthusiasts from around the world. This year a live tracker allowed friends and family back home to watch the progress of their riders. The tracker was my window into the event, cheering as my riders checked through each control and staying up all night when they didn't. Of 97

Canadian starters, 74 arrived safely back in Rambouillet including: just 6 women, 5 riders who arrived slightly over the 90 hour time limit, 2 who arrived within 5 minutes of 90 hours (known as "getting your money's worth"), and a couple of speed demons who finished in around 55 hours. Of course, one of our 6 women finishers was successful in completing her 9th PBP. Equally celebrated, were 56 riders who were there for the first time, of whom 40 made it back to Rambouillet. These riders will have and share the memories of their adventures for years to come, inspiring future randonnées on the roads from Paris to Brest and back!



2019 a été une autre gageure pour de nombreux Canadiens qui se sont rendus en France pour faire PBP, pour vivre quelques intenses journées (et nuits) de vélo avec des milliers d'autres passionnés du monde entier. Cette année, un tracker a permis aux amis et à la famille de suivre de chez eux la progression de leurs randonneurs. Malaysia

Audax Randonneurs Malaysia (ARM) was conceptualised by Sam Tow in 2015. Sam first came across long-distance cycling when he was studying in Perth, Australia. Upon returning to Malaysia he met some new friends who were also interested in covering great distances by bicycle without racing.



"We enjoy riding at our own pace, meeting local people, trying local food, making new friends; what we usually don't get to do in local cycling events" explains Sam. "Our first long-distance ride was 200km. When we posted the invite on social media, everyone said we were insane".

Launching ARM's maiden Brevet 2016, Malaysia had its first official taste of Randonneuring with an event on 2 January 2016. With the help of his friends, Sam organised the first Brevet de Randonneurs Mondiaux (BRM) in Malaysia. They set a modest target of 40 cyclists taking part and were surprised when the number of people who turned up was 10 times their original estimate. This first BRM produced 386 homologated Randonneurs.

With Randonneurs between the ages of 18 and 65, the club has gone from strength to strength. "Our country has been growing very well since 2016, when we had only 2 BRMs. In 2017 we had 5, and

in 2018 we have had one BRM every month.”

In the 2017 “Résultats de nos organisations” published by ACP, Malaysia clocked 1,670,000 km in 2016 and 4,961,000 km in 2017. On 13 January 2018, ARM reached another milestone when 875 cyclists registered for BRM 200 (of which almost 200 cyclists were women).

This proves that Audax in Malaysia is for everyone.

In 2018, ARM held its first-ever BRM 1000. ARM also produced 118 Super Randonneurs in 2018. In 2019, ARM was awarded the fastest growing Audax country in the World. This title was given by ACP during the PBP 2019 ceremony.

What began as only 40 cyclists, ARM has produced more than 5000 homologated Randonneurs to date.

In addition to picturesque Malaysian landscapes, ARM comes up with a variety of new routes for Randonneurs from around the world to enjoy every year. With the interesting challenge of heat during the daytime and an interesting warm rainy season to endure, the Audax challenge in Malaysia is very different from what the legendary PBP offers.

In 2020, ARM plans to organise BRM 200, 300, 400, 600 and 1000 km. And also Flèche Nationale, Trace Nationale, Super Randonnée and LRM 1200. All Randonneurs from anywhere around the world are very welcome to visit Malaysia.

Be our guest and let us host you to the pain, suffering, and enjoyment of Randonneuring in Malaysia, Truly Asia.

Audax Randonneurs Malaisie (ARM) a été conceptualisé par Sam Tow en 2015. Sam a découvert le cyclisme de longue distance lors de ses études à Perth, en Australie. De retour en Malaisie, il s'est fait de nouveaux amis également intéressés par les épreuves longue distance non compétitives.

« Nous aimons rouler à notre propre rythme, rencontrer des gens de la région, tester la nourriture locale, nous faire de

nouveaux amis ; nous n'avons pas l'habitude de faire tout ceci lors des événements cyclistes locaux », explique Sam. « Notre première épreuve longue distance a été de 200 km. Quand nous avons publié l'invitation sur les réseaux sociaux, tout le monde a dit que nous étions fous. »

En inaugurant le premier Brevet d'ARM en 2016, la Malaisie a eu dès le 2 janvier son premier avant-goût officiel de la randonnée. Avec l'aide de ses amis, Sam a organisé les premiers Brevets de Randonneurs Mondiaux (BRM) en Malaisie. Ils se sont fixé un objectif modeste de 40 participants et ont été surpris par le nombre de candidats, 10 fois supérieur à leur estimation. Ce premier BRM a permis d'homologuer 386 randonneurs.

Avec des randonneurs de 18 à 65 ans, le club s'est renforcé. « Notre pays connaît une très bonne croissance depuis 2016, nous n'avions alors que 2 BRM. En 2017, nous en avions 5, et en 2018 nous en avons eu un chaque mois. »

Dans « Résultats de nos organisations 2017 » publié par l'ACP, la Malaisie totalise 1 670 000 km en 2016 et 4 961 000 km en 2017. Le 13 janvier 2018, ARM a franchi une nouvelle étape avec 875 cyclistes inscrits au BRM 200 (dont près de 200 féminines).

Cela prouve que la formule randonneur en Malaisie est accessible à tous.

En 2018, ARM a organisé son tout premier BRM 1000. ARM a également eu 118 Super Randonneurs en 2018. En 2019, ARM a reçu le prix du pays ayant connu la plus forte croissance. Cette récompense a été attribuée par l'ACP lors de la cérémonie de clôture du PBP 2019.

Avec seulement 40 cyclistes à l'origine, ARM a eu plus de 5000 randonneurs homologués à ce jour.

En plus des paysages pittoresques de Malaisie, ARM propose une variété de nouveaux parcours pour que les randonneurs du monde entier en profitent chaque année. Avec la chaleur en journée et la chaude saison des pluies, le défi randonneur en Malaisie est très différent de

celui du légendaire PBP.

En 2020, ARM prévoit d'organiser des BRM 200, 300, 400, 600 et 1000 km. Ainsi qu'une Flèche Nationale, une Trace Nationale, une Super Randonnée et un LRM 1200. Tous les randonneurs du monde sont les bienvenus pour visiter la Malaisie.

Soyez notre invité et laissez-nous vous accoutumer à la douleur, à la souffrance et au plaisir de la randonnée en Malaisie, la véritable Asie.

Des brevets de 200 à 600 km dans les plaines wallachiennes, luttant contre le vent sur des routes interminables,

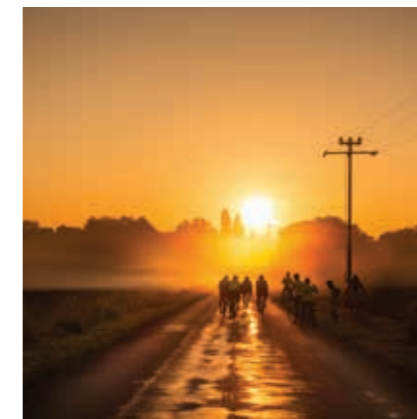

ORGANIZER'S RIDE REPORT

Pre-registrations and Registrations

The process was complicated, because the demand for participation was important, and more than 1600 pre-registrations remained unfulfilled. French riders accounted for only 24% of participants (they are not all regular long-distance riders). It will therefore be necessary to consider reserving a quota of places for French riders, as this event is born and organized in France.

Change of Start and Finish Place

The Rambouillet Castle Park has several advantages: it is a vast enclosed space, with, on one side, access to city center, and on the other side, direct access to the forest of Rambouillet. Cars and campers can park there for the duration of the event. The entire estate has a lot of character, and was appreciated by the participants and the public. On the other hand, the infrastructures are not sufficient for the reception of so many people; it was necessary to install a large marquee, to use various buildings for the dormitories, to set up tents for the exhibitors. Concerning sanitary and showers, improvements are expected for next edition, as autonomous buses with toilet and shower services. Signage also is to be reinforced in this vast space.

Relations with the Bergerie Nationale staff have been excellent.

Procedures for Start and Finish

The heavy rain of the weekend forced us to reconfigure the start area at the last moment, which disrupted the start procedure, especially since the volunteers were not numerous enough to stamp the riders cards. As a result, no group was formed, but riders started in a steady stream, which was not good for the show, nor for all motorists, who had to wait for an interruption of the flow.

Some riders believed that the arch implanted on the road was the finish line arch, while the finish line was located at the arch placed in front of the dove house. Riders did not like the cobblestones and gravels, however no fall was deplored. It will be necessary to review the finish area, and better regulate the flow of cyclists and vehicles. Those who have finished must be attentive to the arrivals!

Route

The route was 11 km shorter than in 2015, with a slightly higher climbing amount. The headwind on the way to Brest (and, for some riders, on the return), has added to the challenge. For safety rea-

sons, we did not want that those riding to Brest cross those on the way back. Many arrows were stolen, and this lack of solidarity among participants got the last riders into trouble.

Safety

Some participants used non-compliant equipment, instead of the high-visibility vest they were given. Some traffic violations resulted in time penalties. It will be necessary to be more severe, to improve the safety of the riders, and avoid accidents. Wearing the helmet is not mandatory, but everyone knows that a head cannot withstand a violent fall! We could have avoided head trauma.

We must thank the Association Normande d'Escorte Cycliste. Once again, they did a remarkable job, securing and helping out riders, who seem to ignore that randonneuring is unsupported cycling.

Rider Tracking

The Chrono Course application was entirely satisfactory. It was very much used by the families and friends of the participants, but also by the participants themselves on their smartphones. It attracted nearly 300,000 unique visitors in 166 countries!

Welcome and Control Places

The sites were all able to cope with the flow of participants, which remained relatively fluid (due to contrary wind and many dropouts), but they could not have welcomed more riders. Musical or commercial entertainment was offered in some sites, attracting people, and assuring a quality welcome.

Catering in Rambouillet

The caterer provided the riders' meals (before the start and after the finish), the volunteers' meals, and the closing buffet. Good job, both in quality and responsiveness.

The Media

Thanks to a lot of work upstream, TV (TF1 with a report in the 8 o'clock news, France 3, CNews, BFM...), radio (Ra-

dio Cyclo...) and press (Les Nouvelles de Rambouillet, Le Parisien, Le Télégramme, Ouest France, L'Equipe...) were present to cover the event.

Entertainment

The expected sound system was not provided; the one found in replacement for start podium and closing speech, was not effective. The accordionist from the Versailles cycling club added some ambience, but we would have liked to have more musicians.

Homologations

A significant number of riders finished out of time (245, excluding those who finished after everything was over), and many did not finish (1790, which represents 27.9%). The continent of Asia has a rate of 61.9% dropouts! Many riders were clearly not prepared for the challenge. It is envisaged to set country

quotas, based on past successes.

Volunteers

The participants are unanimous in recognizing the extreme kindness and helpfulness of the volunteers throughout the course. In Rambouillet, we would have liked to have more volunteers for the many positions to be filled. Those who volunteered for the first time were enthusiastic.

A big thank you to all the actors who contributed to the success of this event. No doubt that the 2019 experience will allow us to prepare a 20th edition in 2023, which will be even more beautiful!

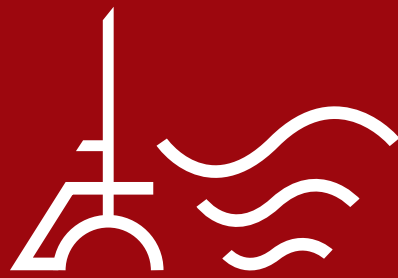
